

Application for International Flying Farmer's MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP AWARD FOR COLLEGE COMPLETION

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANT

The information supplied in this application will serve as the primary basis for determining the successful applicant. Accordingly, you should answer each question as completely as possible. If the space provided is inadequate, your answer should be contained on a separate sheet of paper and attached to the application. Any student is eligible to compete for this award provided he/she is enrolled in his/her Sophomore year in college. **Only the "Revised 2019" form is acceptable. All previous forms should be destroyed.**

In addition to completing the form, you should submit the following with your application:

1. Any information not specifically called by the application that will make the information therein more complete or comprehensive.
2. A transcript of all college credits that you have earned to the date of your application.
3. A recent photograph. The photograph need not be of any particular size or quality but should be clear.
4. Your application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a member of the International Flying Farmers. This letter should include (but need not be limited to) the name and address of the member/sponsor and his/her relationship to you, i.e. parent, grandparents, friend, etc.
5. Your application must also be accompanied by at least two additional letters of recommendation from teachers, friends, or employers.
6. If you are selected for this scholarship and are unable to attend the annual meeting to receive the award in person, you will be expected to send a video. This video should introduce yourself and tell us about your goals; the video should be no longer than 5 minutes.
7. The application must be signed by you and your sponsor and be submitted by March 31 of the year you wish to be considered for the award.
